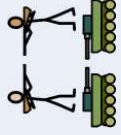
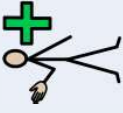
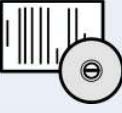


Year 2 – Unit 1 – History – Mary Seacole and Florence Nightingale

Crimean War		A war including Russia, Britain, France and Turkey that happened between 1853-1856 near the Black Sea.
hygiene		Keeping your body and surroundings clean so you stay healthy and don't get sick.
nurse		A person who helps take care of sick or hurt people.
patient		A person who is feeling sick or hurt and needs help from a doctor or a nurse.
source		Something from the past (e.g. a book, photo, object or letter) that helps us to learn about the past.
timeline		A list that shows when important events happened, in the order they took place.

1844	Mary Seacole travels to England to learn more about nursing.
