








EYFS Knowledge Organiser – Traditional Tales and Christmas

Key Vocabulary

Christmas		A Christian holy day that marks the birth of Jesus, who is the son of God.
gas		The state of matter where particles are far apart and move quickly with no fixed shape.
liquid		A substance that can flow and take the shape of its container.
map		A picture of an area that helps us to know where things are and how to find our way.
materials		What an object is made from e.g. wood, plastic, metal, or fabric.
recipe		A set of instructions for cooking and baking, including a list of ingredients.
solid		Something that keeps its own shape and doesn't flow.

Kitchen Rules

Wash Hands Often



Prevent bacteria by washing hands for 20 seconds.

Avoid Cross-Contamination



Use separate tools for raw and cooked foods.

Store Food Safely



Refrigerate perishables and separate raw from cooked items.

Handle Knives Safely



Use sharp knives, cut away from your body, and never leave them loose.

Use Appliances Correctly




Follow instructions, secure blades, and unplug when not in use.
