To know that domesticated animals need food, shelter, exercise and veterinary care all to be provided by people.

To know that domesticated animals can be split into four main groups: mammals, birds, fish and reptiles.

Domesticated	Animals that are cared for by people.
Pets	Animals that live in homes or gardens.
Farm	An area of land and its buildings used for growing crops and raising animals.
Vet	A person who looks after the health of animals.
Diet	The food and drink of animals.
Barn	An outdoor building where animals can shelter.
Carnivore	Carnivores have sharp teeth and claws to eat meat.
Herbivore	Herbivores eat plants. They have flat teeth for grinding.
Omnivore	Omnivores eat meat and plants. They have both sharp and flat teeth.
