Key knowledge

1	The Great Fire of London was caused by a spark from the oven in a bakery.
2	The fire spread quickly because the wooden houses were very close together.
3	There was no fire brigade so people had to put the fire out using buckets of water.
4	Gunpowder was used to blow up houses to stop the fire from spreading.
5	100,000 people were left homeless and 6 people died.
