### Key Information Narborough (United Kingdom)

- A large village in the Blaby district of Leicestershire, England, located southwest of Leicester.
- Close to the motorway and has its own train station.
- The River Soar runs through the village.
- The climate varies between seasons from sunshine in the summer to snow in the winter.
- The village contains many amenities including a doctors, a dentist, several hairdressers, a beauty salon, a Post Office, two estate agents and two chemists. There are also four newsagents, a bakery, a Chinese takeaway, a pizza takeaway, a fish and chip shop, two small supermarkets, two pubs, two Indian restaurants.



### Key Information Naro Moru (Kenya)

- The location of Naro Moru: in Nyeri County in central Kenya, between Nyeri and Nanyuki
- It is called a small town even though its population is much smaller than Narborough
- The town lies on the Naro Moru River
- Naro Moru is close to Mt. Kenya and the land is suited to farming
- Naro Moru bus and car transport to other towns and cities
- Naro Moru has a range of amenities
- The main industry of Naro Moru is tourism, as a base for hikers ascending Mount Kenya, to its east.
- Solio Game Reserve lies near the town.
- The Solio Reserve is internationally recognised as the most successful private rhino breeding reserves in Kenya.
