### **Beaumanor Teddies on Tour Kit list**

We ask that you provide the following kit for your child's residential. This will need to be packed so that the children can carry their kit. Please ensure everything is clearly labelled with their name. Please do not send your child to school wearing expensive clothing or fashion items. The clothes may get dirty, muddy, wet and smelly so old clothes are best.

For both days, a packed lunch will be provided for your child, however, please make sure they have a named reusable drinks bottle for water.

We ask that the children come dressed as a pirate for the first day, please ensure the outfit is practical. Please do not send your child with any props in case these get lost.

Below is a required kit list for the residential. Please put all the required items into **one** bag that the children can carry. During previous years, children brought a large suitcase to fit everything in.

- Pillow in a pillowcase
