Dear Parents and Carers,

We are excited to inform you that the EYFS children will be visiting **Windmill Farm** on **Monday 27th April** as part of our Unit 5: Animal Kingdom.

During the trip, the children will have the opportunity to:

- Meet a real farmer and learn about life on the farm
- See and interact with a variety of farm animals
- Enjoy indoor and outdoor play areas
- Take part in a bug-hunting adventure in Brian's Wood (weather permitting)

The voluntary payment for this trip is **£19.23 per child**, to be paid by **10am on Monday 13th April**. This is set up as a trip on Arbor. This will cover the cost of their entry ticket to the farm, the activities, as well as the coach journeys. Please note:

- If we do not receive enough voluntary contributions to cover the cost of the visit, the trip will not be able to go ahead. In this case, all payments will be fully refunded.
- The school does not have any additional funds to subsidise this activity.

We will be leaving promptly just after 9:00am, so it is important that children arrive at school on time. We aim to return to school as normal for the end of the day.

As the majority of the day will be spent outdoors, please ensure your child is dressed appropriately. Children should wear:

- Comfortable, suitable shoes for walking and outdoor play
- A waterproof coat

Please make sure all items are clearly labelled.

Children will need to bring a packed lunch with them, along with a drink and snack. These need to be labelled and ideally all fit in the same bag, which they can carry. A small backpack would be ideal. Our caterers can provide a packed lunch for your child if you wish, which will consist of a ham, cheese or tuna sandwich with crudites, a piece of fruit and a biscuit. If you wish to order a school lunch, please indicate your child's preference for the sandwich filling no later than **Monday 13th April** by emailing admin@rhf.learnat.uk. No bookings on Arbor will be taken into account for that day.
