Dear Parents and Carers,

We are very excited to be able to visit The Children's Country House at Sudbury Hall on Wednesday 14th January 2026. This visit links directly to our current History topic: Toys from the Past. During the trip, children will become Toy Detectives, exploring the fascinating differences between toys from the past and those we enjoy today. They will:

- Investigate how toys have changed over time, focusing on their materials, colours, and uses.
- Handle real toys from different periods.
- Explore the toy galleries and other museum spaces that showcase aspects of children's lives throughout history.

The voluntary payment for this trip is £22.67 per child. This is set up as a trip on Arbor, and will be available from 12pm 28th November until 12pm 5th January. This will cover the cost of their entry ticket to the venue as well as the coach journeys. Please note:

- If we do not receive enough funds to cover the full cost of the trip, it will not be viable and therefore will have to be cancelled. In this event, a full refund will be given to those who have paid.
- The school does not have any additional funds to subsidise this activity.

We will review payments made before we break up for Christmas, then again once we have returned to check the viability of the trip. Please make your payment no later than midday 5th January 2026.

The coach will depart from RHF at 9am after registration so a prompt arrival to school is essential. The return coach will leave Sudbury Hall at 2pm, aiming to be back before the end of the school day. Staff on the trip will liaise with the office staff to alert you of any delays.

Children will need to bring a packed lunch with them, along with a drink and snack. These need to be labelled and ideally all fit in the same bag which they can carry. A small backpack would be ideal. Our caterers can provide a packed lunch for your child if you wish, which will consist of a ham,



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cheese or tuna sandwich with crudites, a piece of fruit and a biscuit. If you wish to have a school lunch, please indicate your child's preference for the sandwich filling no later than 7th January. No bookings on Arbor will be taken into account for that day. Please ensure that children wear full school uniform for this visit and bring a warm coat with them as parts of the visit may be outside.
