Dear Parents/Carers,

As our Call of the Wild residential is fast approaching, we would like to provide you with some key information.

On the morning of the trip, we will aim to leave Red Hill Field at 8am, so would ask that the children arrive in school by **7.30am** and come straight to the classroom with their luggage. Please ensure that any medication is passed over to a member of staff, who will be in the Year 6 cloakroom, along with any instructions and further information about the administration of that medication. If there is any new or additional information you wish to pass on to us, please do not wait until the morning of the trip as it will be very busy.

Please provide your child with a packed lunch inside a plastic bag (please do not bring a lunch box) and a drink for the first day. It would be helpful if these could be carried within rucksacks.

As we explained at our information evening, the children participate in a range of activities including: canoeing, caving, waterfall walking and rock climbing. Because of the activities we will be participating in, it is important that the children have everything on the kit list, with plenty of 'spares' such as socks etc.

Call of the Wild supply all safety equipment needed for each activity. This includes helmets and waterproof overalls.

They **do not** need a pillow but will be required to bring a sleeping bag and a pillowcase.

If you would like to provide your child with a disposable camera for the trip, then please make sure this is clearly labelled with their name and remind them of their responsibilities.
