All of the clubs will be bookable and payable for on ParentPay and the payment items for these will be available shortly. The clubs will only be visible to the parents of children that are eligible to book them (i.e. children in year 1 will only be able to see clubs available for year 1 children). If you are able to book and pay for a club then their place in that club is then booked and guaranteed, you will not receive another confirmation email.



If you are booking an activity club and no longer require your afterschool club booking for that day, please inform the school office. If you still require your child to attend afterschool club after the activity club, please get in touch and we will arrange this for you. This will be charged at £5.50 as a short session, and they will receive a snack.

There is an expectation that any clubs booked and paid for will be attended for the whole half term unless there are extenuating circumstances. If you miss out on booking your desired club this time, please be assured that there will be plenty of opportunities coming up later in the year.
