Dear Parents and Carers,

We are delighted to inform you that we have organised a residential trip for our future Year 4 children to the Hollowford centre in Derbyshire. This will take place from Monday 27th March to Wednesday 29th March 2023. The children will be staying in very modern en-suite dormitories and taking part in a variety of exciting activities such as canoeing, weaselling (rock climbing), high ropes and team building activities. We have decided to share this information as early as possible with you, as the cost of the trip has unfortunately increased since this year. We have negotiated as much as possible with the centre, however they cannot reduce it further. The general increase in various costs means that the trip will be £236 per child. This includes the activities, travel and meals. We are breaking this down into as many instalments as ParentPay will allow, which are detailed below. You will note we have given you a 2 month break over the Christmas period.

We are aware that in the current financial climate this may be difficult for some parents, but we would like all children to attend, as this is a fabulous opportunity for them to develop independence and learn some new skills.

First instalment	£47.20 by 1 st September 2022
Second instalment	£47.20 by 1 st October 2022
Third instalment	£47.20 by 1 st November 2022
Fourth instalment	£47.20 by 1 st February 2023
Fifth instalment	£47.20 by 1 st March 2023

ParentPay will require certain information to be filled out, such as emergency contacts, medical/dietary requirements etc. Please fill this out when making the first payment.

If you are Pupil Premium eligible, please contact the school office as we may be able to help with the cost of this trip. If you are not in receipt of Pupil Premium but think you might be eligible, please contact the school office.

We will be holding an information meeting in the next academic year. As soon as details for this have been organised, we will communicate them to you.
