Dear Parents and Carers,

On Monday 28th March, we have arranged to visit Leicester Central Mosque to enrich the children's understanding of Islam which we are learning about in our Religious Education lessons. The educational visit will allow the children to explore the inside of a Mosque and give the children greater insight into what it means to be a Muslim.

The children will need to be in school uniform. There are no dress code or restrictions for guests visiting a mosque. It is not compulsory for females to cover their hair, but your child may wish to do so out of respect and can bring a scarf if this is their preference.

Although the visit to the mosque is without cost, we kindly ask for a £4.70 contribution to the cost of travel. This will be set up and assigned to your child on ParentPay. The trip will take place in the morning and all children will be back at school for their lunch.

This enriching trip will provide the opportunity for your child to experience religions and will lead to a better understanding of other people and the world around them. Visits to sacred spaces bring the agreed syllabus to life and underpin the role of RE in helping to prepare and equip pupils for life and citizenship in today's diverse and plural Britain.
