Dear Parents and Carers,

We are delighted to be able to share with you some more information about the fantastic after school activity clubs that will be running next half term. Some of the clubs will be running throughout the whole year, whilst others will be for a set number of weeks. Please read on to find out everything you need to know about all of the clubs and how you book your child a place.

Autumn Term 2:


Film Club	Years 4, 5 and 6
<p>Restarting on 25th October and running every Monday throughout the whole year, this club will be led by Mr Chilton. In connection with intofilm.org, students will watch and review films. They will also become a member of intofilm.org and have the opportunity to create online reviews for them which gives them a chance of winning a fortnightly Amazon gift card. Following this, all aspects of film making will be looked at and children will start to create and produce their own films!</p> <p>The children will continue to create their own story and characters and bringing it all to life with the magic of film.</p>	
Running time:	13 th Sept 2021 – July 2022 Payable half termly, your place in the club will be renewed each half term when you will be given the option to pay again if they wish to remain at the club
Spaces:	Currently offered to those already in the Club. If spaces become available, we will inform you.
Cost:	£38.50 for second half term (7 weeks at £5.50 each week)




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Football Club	Years 4, 5 and 6
Mr Vella-Blake will taking football training for years 4,5 and 6 on Mondays from 25 th October. These sessions are with a view to develop our school's Football team moving forward in the years to come. The school team will compete in local competitions and will be picked primarily from Year 6, (this is the case for most schools) but by including years 4 and 5 we hope that we can prepare and create strong school teams for years to come.	
Running time:	w/c 25th October – w/c 6 th December 2021 Payable half termly, your place in the club will be renewed each half term when you will be given the option to pay again if they wish to remain at the club.
Spaces:	25 places, first come first served
Cost:	£24.50 for the half term (7 weeks at £3.50 each week)

Art Club	Years 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6
Do you love arts and crafts as much as Mrs Crofts? Come and join us for a fun and creative time. We will make a range of beautiful and unique crafts to take home allowing your creative mind to shine. Mrs Crofts will be bringing her outstanding artistic skills and sharing her knowledge with children in years 1, 2 and 3 on Tuesdays and years 4, 5 and 6 on Thursdays from the week commencing 25 th October.

Spaces:	15 places available for each day, first come first served
Cost:	£38.50 for the half term (7 weeks at £5.50 each week)



Board Game Club	Years 4, 5 and 6
<p>Board games have moved on a lot in the last few years it's not about passing GO or working out who used the candle stick in the dining room, now you have to work together to save your castle from an Orc attack, fight ghosts to get to the treasure, strategically move insects to surround your opponent's Queen. On Wednesdays from 27th October, Mr Chilton will introduce and teach children a range of games. They will be able to try many different games and then review and teach others their favourite ones.</p>

Netball Club	Years 4, 5 and 6
<p>Miss Marshall and Mrs Mason will lead netball training for years 4, 5 and 6 every Tuesday. They will also be looking to develop a school team which will compete in local competitions within the Bee Netball Network and other matches against local schools. The school team will be picked primarily from Year 6, (this is the case for most schools) but by including years 4 and 5 we hope that we can prepare and create strong school teams for years to come.</p>	
Running time:	w/c 25 th October – w/c 6 th December 2021 Payable half termly, your place in the club will be renewed each half term when you will be given the option to pay again if they wish to remain at the club.
Spaces:	30 places, first come first served
Cost:	£24.50 for the half term (7 weeks at £3.50 each week)



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Activity Club	Years 1, 2 and 3
On Mondays, Mrs Asher will lead a variety of activities such as games and STEM projects (Science Technology Engineering and Maths)	
 	
Running time:	w/c 25 th October – w/c 6 th December 2021 Payable half termly for this block only.
Spaces:	15 places available, first come first served
Cost:	£38.50 for the half term (7 weeks at £5.50 each week)

Fizz Pop Science	Years 1 to 6
Fizz Pop Science will be returning to Red Hill Field to lead 2 blocks of sessions, one after the half term break, the other after Christmas. The children will be told all about the world of Fizz Pop Science during an assembly next week, after which they will receive an information letter and booking form to bring home, detailing the times, costs, etc.	
Running time:	Tuesdays from 26 th October for 6 weeks for Key Stage 2, then Tuesdays from 11 th January for 5 weeks for Key Stage 1
Spaces:	20 places available per block, first come first served, bookable online with Fizz Pop Science.
Cost:	£45 for the 6 week block, £38 for the 5 week block

After the Christmas break, Film Club, Football and Netball will continue primarily with the same members. We will inform you if spaces become available. Art Club, Activity Club and Board Games Club will restart with a new group of pupils.



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All of the clubs will be bookable and payable for on ParentPay and the payment items for these will be available soon. We will send out an email once these have gone live. The clubs will only be visible to the parents of children that are eligible to book them (i.e. children in year 1 will only be able to see clubs available for year 1 children). If you are able to book and pay for a club then their place in that club is then booked and guaranteed, you will not receive another confirmation email.

All clubs will be running 3:15pm to 4:30pm apart from Film Club which will run until 5pm. Once you have booked a club you will receive further information next week with details about anything your child may need to bring (sport's kit, etc) and where they need to be collected from.

If you are booking an activity club and no longer require your afterschool club booking for that day, please inform the school office. If you still require your child to attend afterschool club after the activity club, please get in touch and we will book them into the short session option.

There is an expectation that any clubs booked and paid for will be attended for the whole half term unless there are extenuating circumstances. If you miss out on booking your desired club this time, please be assured that there will be plenty of opportunities coming up later in the year and we will prioritise those who missed out first.

We are really excited to get started and bring this range of enriching activities to our school programme. This is still a reasonably a new venture for us, we are sure there may be further questions and queries that come up so please bear with us while we endeavour to get things running as smoothly as possible.
